### Adriene at home, in the saddle

Do you know Adriene Kramer? Adriene is truly home grown, having been born and raised in Yellow Springs and starting at the Riding Centre at the tender age of eight. From an auspicious start as a beginner student, she went on to teach riding lessons at the Centre by the age of 16. Carolyn Bailey remembers her as one of those riding students who was a natural: "Adriene always listened better and tried harder. That made it easy for me to find ways to use her strong desire to be around horses by letting her help train green horses, helping with lessons, and eventually teaching her own classes."

## Adriene eventually found herself back home at the Riding Centre

Adriene knew she wanted to pursue horses as a career. For her, there was no choice but to find a university with a strong equine studies program. She found that in Johnson & Wales University in Providence, Rhode Island. Through this nationally known equine studies program, she was exposed to top dressage and eventing clinicians, which fueled her passion for horses even more. While in college, she began amassing practical experience working as a groom for a top-level Canadian dressage rider at the Pan-American Games. In 1999, with a bachelors degree in Equine Business Management/Riding in hand, she got a job working for an international-level event rider. In 2001, she switched gears and went to work at a dude ranch out west, where she was a wrangler for three seasons, rounding out her experience with different Western riding disciplines, riding hundreds of horses, and teaching riding to guests of all different riding levels. Working at the ranch also changed her life in other important ways, too. At the ranch, she was introduced to

Centered Riding,<sup>®</sup> and she met her future husband, Jeff. Centered Riding inspired her to become a thoughtful riding teacher with a thirst for knowledge to help her students progress. Jeff has been her partner and support through all her endeavors.

In 2005, Adriene eventually found herself back home at the Riding Centre once again, this time with a horse (Georgia), a dog (Sadie), a cat (Punky), and a husband (yes, that would be Jeff!) in tow. She is one of only six certified Centered Riding instructors in Ohio, and in 2010, she took the step to become a Level II ARIA (American Riding Instructors Association) certified riding instructor in both dressage and eventing. Through her expertise and varied knowledge, Adriene has become an indispensable part of the Riding Centre's lesson program as assistant riding instructor. When Carolyn is asked about working with Adriene, she is quick to respond: "Having Adriene back at the Centre as

a co-worker and friend is a thrill for me. Knowing that she shares similar views on how horses should be ridden and loved is a comfort to me. Students at the Centre are lucky to benefit from her instruction, and we are grateful for her hard work and dedication." Carolyn greatly values Adriene's calm approach to teaching and her considerable skill as a rider, both of which are enormous assets to the Riding Centre.

When asked to talk about herself, Adriene is modest, almost to a fault. When the Riding Centre comes up, she warms to the subject immediately: "The Riding Centre has helped to instill a great work ethic in me. I see how hard everyone here works. Horses don't take any days off; they need

care every day." She adds, "Carolyn has been a mentor and role model to me since I started riding. She has a great ability to treat everyone with incredible kindness, yet is a strong leader who can bring the best out of anyone." About the atmosphere at the Riding Centre: "I love that the Riding Centre doesn't have egos and, like Yellow Springs, is a little more understated. We do things well but are not fancy. Our strength is in our emphasis on safety and fun, not showing and competing, which can be really expensive. The Riding Centre has always been a place I have been proud to come from, just like Yellow Springs."

Over the years, many riding students have passed through the Riding Centre on their journey seeking an understanding of horses. Some students briefly enjoy the benefits, moving on to other pursuits as their lives change. Rarely, a student becomes transformed by the experience, and life must include horses. Adriene Kramer is one of those rare students who discovered a passion for horses at a young age at the Riding Centre and has gone on to make horses not only her passion but her life's work.


